Iman Hajirasouliha is Professor of Structural Engineering at the University of Sheffield, UK, where he serves as the Academic Line Manager of Structures and leader of the Earthquake Engineering Group (EEG).

With over two decades of experience in research and consultancy, his innovative work in earthquake engineering, sustainable lightweight steel structures, performance-based optimization and artificial intelligence has led to over 300 refereed journal and conference publications. Prof. Hajirasouliha has been Principal or Co-investigator of over €10M EU and UK-funded projects, and holds membership in several prestigious international technical committees, including *fib* Task Groups 6.6 and 7.6, IABSE Task Group 1.1, and BSI Committee CB/203. He is currently an Associate Editor of “Structures (Elsevier)”, “Practice Periodical on Structural Design and Construction (ASCE)” and “Frontiers in Built Environment (Earthquake Engineering Section)”. Prof. Hajirasouliha's contributions to his field have been widely recognised, and he is among the world's top 2% scientists in his discipline, according to the database published by Stanford University and Elsevier.
