Krzysztof Józwiakowski is a professor in the field of environmental engineering at the University of Life Sciences in Lublin (Poland), Department of Environmental Engineering. His research and development activities include practical aspects of water and wastewater management, water quality and

protection, water and wastewater technology. In particular his research interests focus on the use of constructed wetland systems for wastewater treatment and sewage sludge disposal, as well as rainwater management. He cooperates with numerous communes and 2 national parks (Polesie National Park, Roztocze National Park), where he conducts research and implementation work in the field of water and wastewater management. This activity includes the design and implementation of Nature Based Solutions (NBS), and above all constructed wetland systems for both water, wastewater treatment, dewatering and stabilization of sewage sludge as well as rainwater management systems. Recently he has been collaborating with many scientific institutions all over the world, such as: Polytechnic Institute of Beja, Portugal; Lviv Polytechnic National University, Ukraine; Aarhus University, Denmark; Technical University of Crete, Chania, Greece; Universitat Politècnica de Catalunya-BarcelonaTech, Barcelona, Spain. He is an author and co-author of 88 publications indexed in the Scopus database and over 100 other peer-reviewed publications in journals, conference materials and monographs. He is also a co-author of 3 patents and one utility model.

The H-index of professor Krzysztof Józwiakowski is 20, and his scientific works have been cited 1400 times according to the Scopus database. He has supervised 6 PhD students and over 80 master's theses. He is a deputy chairman of the Committee on Environmental Engineering of the Polish Academy of Sciences. He is also a deputy chairman of the Lublin Branch of the Polish Society of Ecological Engineering. He currently holds the positions of: chairman of the Scientific Council of the Discipline of Environmental Engineering, Mining and Energy and Head of the Department of Environmental Engineering at the University of Life Sciences in Lublin. He is also a member of the Scientific Council of the Roztocze National Park, a member of the Scientific Council of the Polesie National Park, as well as a member of the Regional Council for Nature Protection at the Regional Directorate for Environmental Protection in Lublin.
